I'm an award-winning series producer and producer-director with over 100 credits for broadcast TV - mainly for terrestrial primetime. My passion and specialist expertise is strong human interest stories: carefully observed programmes about people undergoing transformational experiences, sometimes under extreme circumstances!

For Channel 4 I produced and directed *The Big Trip* - four self-filmed one-hours about young people undertaking epic adventures; I produced and directed two series of *Faith & Music* for ITV1 - revealing and intimate films with major recording artists; I produced and directed three series of observational documentaries for ITV1 following helicopter search and rescue teams around British coasts. I've series produced a wide range of factual programming - everything from ob-doc to studio debates to constructed documentary and investigative current affairs: I developed the *Dispatches* programme for Channel 4, *Killing for Honour*, that broke the story about honour killings within the British Muslim community.

I'm fascinated by the possibilities new digital technologies bring to create new levels of interaction, new forms of storytelling and gameplay. As a recent graduate of the Crossover Digital Media Lab, I love the potential this holds to reach new audiences and create experiences that users can access on platforms beyond the limits of traditional TV broadcasting.
